

Established in 2008, this successful reading group is open to those with a shared interest in Jung. It aims to carry out a systematic reading of C.G. Jung's original works and explore their significance in academic and clinical contexts, including taking into account post-Jungian perspectives in analytical psychology.

Last year, the group studied a series of seminars on active imagination Jung gave in Zurich from 1939 to 1940, based on Ignatius of Loyola's spiritual exercises.

who it is for

The reading group is open to those with a shared interest in reading Jung's works. Current participants include analysts, psychotherapists, trainees and people with an academic background. Prior knowledge of subjects is not assumed, but the ability to openly engage with the reading material is an essential part of the group's discussions.

The group is led by Katerina Sarafidou who will help select the monthly reading from Jung's works, provide short introductions to the material and facilitate the discussion.
